Call for Papers

The meeting of ILAIS members will be held this year in accordance with [ECIS2014](#), in the form of a half-day mini-conference on Sunday, June 8, 2014 from 13:30-18:00, leading into the ECIS reception, at the **Academic College of Tel-Aviv Yaffo**. The theme of this meeting is “**Teaching IS: Lessons Learned from Israel**”. In addition to bringing together Israeli scholars, the purpose is to draw the attention of ECIS international participants to current teaching IS in Israel and to provide a forum for educational conversation, academic dialog, and collaboration.

The program will include parallel sessions of short presentations (20 minutes) for which we seek contributions from scholars who focus on the above theme. The contribution can be in the form of a theoretical or empirical research paper, a teaching case that demonstrate new practices or effectiveness of practices and tools, or novel ideas or approaches in educating students of IS. Consistent with the ECIS2014 conference theme, “Digital Work, Digital Life”, we welcome submissions that shed light on the ways in which mobile, new-media, social, organizational, and educational technologies are practiced in Israeli IS programs and courses. We plan to ensure time for constructive discussions that could lead to future collaborations; e.g., ideas for sharing resources and co-developing infrastructures & materials are welcomed.

The topics of submissions include, but are not limited to, the following broad areas of teaching:

- Project-based learning
- Collaborative learning and teaching
- Using case studies
- Using Open Educational Resources (OER)
- New ways of assessment and evaluation
- Using technology in IT courses

Faculty members in the IS field and those who teach IS more broadly are encouraged to submit a one-page proposal, in English, in the [ECIS paper format](#) by April **22**, 2014 to ILAIS2014event@gmail.com. Authors must grant ILAIS the right to publish the proposal online prior to the meeting, but retain all other copyrights. This arrangement allows you to publish the complete version elsewhere.
