The Program Committee invites faculty members, research students, and industry researchers in the IS field to submit an **extended abstract** for the following tracks:

- **Full Presentation:** Submissions to this track must reflect completed research works. Accepted submissions under this track will be allocated with extended presentation time during the conference. An extended abstract submitted for this track should include: title, author(s), introduction, objectives, method, results, and conclusions. The structure can be adjusted as needed.
- **Short Presentation:** Submissions to this track may reflect either completed research works or research in progress. Accepted submissions under this track will be allocated with shorter presentation time during the conference. An extended abstract submitted for this track should include: title, author(s), introduction, objectives, method, and initial results and conclusions, if available. The structure can be adjusted as needed.

Please note: Authors for the both tracks retain all copyrights and will be asked to agree to publish their abstracts online as conference proceedings. This arrangement allows publishing the complete version elsewhere (including journals, conferences and books).
